

The Whitworth 8-man Football Camp is open to all high school football players who will enter grades 9-12 in fall 2013. This is a contact football camp designed to give each camper instruction in football fundamentals and technique. Individual sessions will be taught by Whitworth Head Football Coach John Tully and the Whitworth Pirate football staff, as well as by other selected coaches.

John Tully is in his 18th season as head football coach at Whitworth and was named Northwest Conference Coach of the Year in 2001, 2006 and 2007. The Whitworth Pirates were the 2001, 2006 and 2007 Northwest Conference Champions and made the 2001 and 2006 NCAA Division III National Playoffs.

**Camp Description**  
June 17-19

**The camp format** allows each high school the opportunity to bring its entire football team to practice together.

**Camp fees:** The cost for residential campers is \$210, which includes a camp T-shirt, breakfast, lunch, dinner and housing in a residence hall. A \$50 deposit (*non-refundable after June 10*) is required.

**Registration:** Registration will take place in the Hixson Union Building on Monday, June 17, from 10 a.m.-12:15 p.m. Camp payment is due in full at the time of registration.

**Checkout:** Players will check out before the luncheon on Wednesday, June 19.

**Football equipment:** All camp athletes should bring a complete set of football gear including shoulder pads; helmet; jersey; pants with hip, thigh and knee pads; shorts; shoes; socks; athletic supporter; and a mouthpiece. Football equipment is available for rent on a first-come, first-served basis for a \$50 fee. **(QB's and receivers should bring their own footballs.)**

**Items to bring:** Personal toiletries; towels; pillow; bedding or a sleeping bag; swimsuit; alarm clock; sunscreen; sweats; T-shirts; shorts and tennis shoes.

**Supervision:** The camp staff reserves the right to dismiss anyone who displays unacceptable behavior during the camp. There will be no refund for expulsion or voluntary withdrawal from the Whitworth 8-man Football Camp.

**Medical insurance:** All campers are required to provide their own medical insurance.
